A man in his late twenties is approached by Clara who introduces herself to him at a large Christmas party in Manhattan, and the two meet every night at the same movie theater, growing by turns closer together and farther apart as they contemplate falling in love.

### F AMIS

**Amis, Martin. *The pregnant widow : inside history*. 1<sup>st</sup> North American ed. New York : Knopf, 2010.**

In the summer of 1970, Keith Nearing, a twenty-year-old college student, stays in a castle in Italy with a group of friends, including his girlfriend Lily and her beautiful but shallow friend, Scheherazade, with whom he is hopelessly and desperately in love. Keith's hapless attempts to secretly court Scheherazade shape his subsequent love life for decades to come.

Police sergeant Hamish Macbeth investigates the death of a young woman, who had many secrets, while trying to avoid marrying his constable, the pretty Josie McSween, who has trapped him into an engagement.

### F BEST

**The best American mystery stories 2009. Boston : Houghton Mifflin Harcourt, 2009.**

Jeffery Deaver selects twenty works of American mystery writing as the best of the genre from the year 2008, including pieces by Tom Bissell, Robert McClure, Joyce Carol Oates, and others.

### F BEUTNER

**Beutner, Katharine. *Alcestis*. New York : Soho, c2010.**

A vivid reimagining of a classical Greek myth.

### F BISHOP

#### **F BLACK**

**Black, Holly. *The poison eaters and other stories.* 1<sup>st</sup> ed. Easthampton, MA : Big Mouth House, 2010.**

A collection of short stories for younger readers that feature fantasy elements and illustrations, including "The Coldest Girl in Coldtown," "The Boy Who Cried Wolf," "Paper Cuts Scissors," and more.

#### **F BRADLEY**

**Bradley, C. Alan, 1938-. *The weed that strings the hangman's bag : a Flavia de Luce mystery.* 1<sup>st</sup> ed. New York : Delacorte Press, c2010.**

Flavia de Luce, an eleven-year-old sleuth, sets aside her chemistry experiments to solve the mystery behind the death of an unfortunate puppeteer—who was electrocuted—and attempts to discover how his death is connected to a cold case that the local constables have been unable to solve.

#### **F BROWN**

**Brown, Rita Mae. *Cat of the century : a Mrs. Murphy mystery.* 1<sup>st</sup> ed. New York : Bantam Books, c2010.**

Mary Minor "Harry" Haristeen travels to William Woods University in Fulton, Missouri, to attend a celebration and fundraiser in honor of her beloved Aunt Tally's one hundredth birthday, and becomes involved in investigating the mysterious withdrawal and replacement of \$25,000 from the alumnae association's account by board member Mariah D'Angelo who subsequently disappeared.

#### **F BRUNSTETTER**

**Brunstetter, Wanda E. *Kelly's chance. Uhrichsville, OH : Barbour, c2004.***

Kelly longs to pursue her artistic talents, rather than lead her parent's mules to deliver coal to the city, and gets a chance when Mike, a shopkeeper, takes an interest in Kelly and her drawings, but Mike's differing religious beliefs do not sit well with Kelly.

#### **F CANNELL**

**Cannell, Dorothy. *Withering heights.* 1<sup>st</sup> ed. New York : St. Martin's Minotaur, 2007.**

Part-time sleuth and mother of three, Ellie Haskell, is approached by her husband's cousin, Ariel, to investigate some strange happenings at their new home at the Yorkshire moors, and faces not only a potential killer, but her husband's old flame as well.

#### **F CHERRYH**

**Cherryh, C. J. *The faded sun : Kutath. Garden City, N.Y. : N. Doubleday, c1979.***

Kutath was an ancient world and a dying one. In ages past, its best sons and daughters had gone to the stars to serve as mercenaries in the wars of aliens. Now the survivors of its star-flung people, the mri, had come back—in the form of a single woman, the last priestess-queen Melein, and a single man, the last warrior Nuin. And one other—the human Sten Duncan who had deserted Earth's military forces to swear service to the foes of his own species.

#### **F CHIAVERINI LP**

**Chiaverini, Jennifer. *The lost quilter. Large print ed. New York : Simon & Schuster, c2009.***

Master quilter Sylvia Compson discovers a stash of letters in the attic of Elm Creek Manor and traces a tale back to 1859. An escaped slave, Joanna, spent a brief period at Elm Creek Farm until she was captured and returned to bondage, leaving her son in the care of the Bergstrom family. If Sylvia is to determine the fate of Joanna and her son, she must rely on one important clue—the meticulous heirloom quilt Joanna stitched and left behind.

**Chiaverini, Jennifer. *A quilter's holiday. Large print ed. Detroit : Thorndike Press, 2009.***

The Elm Creek Quilters come together the day after Thanksgiving to work on quilt blocks and projects that represent their thankfulness and gratitude and share stories of love, family, and friends.

#### **F CLARK**

**Clark, Carol Higgins. *Cursed : a Regan Reilly mystery.* 1<sup>st</sup> Scribner hardcover ed. New York : Scribner, 2009.**

Regan Reilly agrees to help Abigail Feeney, who believes she has been cursed since birth, track down her ex-boyfriend, Cody Castle, who owes Abigail more than \$100,000, but when the search is plagued by bad luck, Reilly begins to wonder if Abigail's curse is rubbing off on her.

## **F CLARK**

**Clark, Clare. *Savage lands*. Boston : Houghton Mifflin Harcourt, 2010.**

Elizabeth, one of twenty-three girls sent from France to become a wife in colonial Louisiana, surprises herself when she falls in love with her soldier husband, Jean-Claude; meanwhile, Auguste, a cabin boy, is tasked with mastering the language of the Native Americans for the colony's governor and befriends Jean-Claude, who eventually betrays both Elizabeth and Auguste.

## **F CLARK**

**Clark, Carol Higgins. *Laced : a Regan Reilly mystery*. 1<sup>st</sup> Scribner hardcover ed. New York : Scribner, 2007.**

Tracing their ancestry to a small Dublin town while honeymooning in Ireland, newlyweds Regan and Jack Reilly learn disturbing information about their families—with the help of Jack's colleagues at the Major Case Squad.

## **F CLEVIDENCE**

**Clevidence, Carin, 1967-. *The house on Salt Hay Road*. 1<sup>st</sup> ed. New York : Farrar, Straus and Giroux, 2010.**

The Scudder family of Long Island, a household that includes patriarch August, his adult son and daughter Roy and Mavis, and his orphaned grandchildren, nineteen-year-old Nancy and her younger brother Clayton, is disrupted by an explosion at a nearby fireworks factory and further unsettled by Nancy's announcement that she plans to marry a young man from Boston.

## **F CONNOLLY**

**Connolly, John, 1968-. *The gates*. 1<sup>st</sup> Atria Books hardcover ed. New York : Atria Books, 2009.**

Young Samuel Johnson and his dachshund Boswell decide to begin their trick-or-treating three days before Halloween, but when he arrives upon the Abernathy's house at 666 Crowley Avenue, Samuel discovers they have inadvertently conjured up Satan and Samuel must use science, faith, and love to defeat the evil and save the world.

## **F COULTER**

**Coulter, Catherine. *Whiplash*. New York : Putnam's, c2010.**

FBI agents Dillon Savich and Lacey Sherlock investigate the murder of a foreign employee of the drug company that was supplying a chemotherapy drug to Edward Kender's father, and the private detective hired by Kender to find out why supplies of the drug ran out uncovers a plot by Schiffer Hartwin to make billions of dollars for the illegal sale of Culwort.

## **F COWELL**

**Cowell, Stephanie. *Claude & Camille : a novel of Monet*. 1<sup>st</sup> ed. New York : Crown Publishers, c2010.**

Dramatizes the complex love story between artist Claude Monet and Camille Doniceaux as Monet struggles to gain recognition while the couple faces financial and personal challenges.

## **F CRAIS LP**

**Crais, Robert. *The first rule*. Large print ed. Waterville, Me. : Wheeler Windsor Paragon, 2010.**

Frank Meyer, a former military contractor and mercenary who used to work with Joe Pike, loses his family when a professional crew raids his home, but when the police suspect Meyer to have been hiding something, Elvis Cole helps Pike search beyond grudges, blackmail, and double crosses in an effort to clear Meyer's name.

## **F CRICHTON LP**

**Crichton, Michael, 1942-2008. *Pirate latitudes : a novel*. 1<sup>st</sup> HarperLuxe ed., [Large print ed.]. New York : HarperLuxe, c2009.**

On Jamaica, a remote Caribbean colony in 1665, Captain Charles Hunter plots to steal Spanish gold from the galleon "El Trinidad," which awaits repairs in a nearby, heavily fortified harbor that is guarded by Cazalla, a bloodthirsty commander.

## **F CROUCH**

**Crouch, Katie. *Men and dogs : a novel*. 1<sup>st</sup> ed. New York : Little, Brown, 2010.**

Twenty years after her father's mysterious disappearance, Hannah Legare returns to her family home in Charleston, South Carolina, hoping to learn what really happened on that long ago day that changed her life.

## **F CURZON**

**Curzon, Clare. Devil in the detail : a Superintendent Mike Yeadings mystery. 1<sup>st</sup> world ed. Sutton, Surrey, England : Severn House, 2010.**

Superintendent Mike Yeadings is called to the Plummer estate, where a young woman's body has been found, and when he discovers the victim has been dead for more than a year, Mike fears the killer is getting ready to strike again.

## **F CUSSLER**

**Cussler, Clive. The spy. New York : G.P. Putnam's Sons, c2010.**

The Van Dorn Detective Agency assigns Isaac Bell, a private investigator, to a case that will reveal whether a brilliant American battleship gun designer's death was a suicide or murder, but Bell uncovers a plot set to destroy the great minds of America that are somehow connected to a secret project known as Hull 44.

## **F DE LINT**

**De Lint, Charles, 1951-. Muse and reverie. 1<sup>st</sup> ed. New York : Tor, 2009.**

A collection of short fiction stories by Canadian author Charles De Lint, set in the fictional city of Newford.

## **F DEKKER**

**Dekker, Ted, 1962-. The bride collector. 1<sup>st</sup> ed. New York : Center Street, 2010.**

Brad Raines, a special agent for the FBI who is trying to solve a serial killer case in which a bridal veil is left at each crime scene, approaches the Center for Wellness and Intelligence, a psychiatric institution with gifted clients, and when he enlists the help of Paradise, a young woman who can experience the final moments of a person's life when touching their dead body, he wonders if he can prevent the next murder.

## **F DELILLO**

**DeLillo, Don. Point Omega : a novel. 1<sup>st</sup> Scribner hardcover ed. New York : Scribner, 2010.**

After his years using his intelligence to serve the United States government, Richard Elster retreats to the desert where a filmmaker, Jim Finley, tries to persuade Elster to participate in a one-take documentary film, and Elster's daughter visits from New York.

## **F DEMILLE**

**DeMille, Nelson. The lion : a novel. 1<sup>st</sup> ed. New York : Grand Central Pub., 2010.**

John Corey fears his allotment of good luck may have run out when he signs on as a contract agent with the federal government's Anti-Terrorist Task Force and is assigned to apprehend an alleged Libyan terrorist known as "The Lion."

## **F DREWE**

**Drewe, Robert, 1943-. Ned Kelly. New York : Penguin Books, 2003, c1991.**

The first novel written about the bushcountry gunslinger who was both the national hero and devil incarnate of Australia, Ned Kelly imagines the inner life of a figure described by historian Manning Clark as "a wild ass of a man, snarling, roaring and frothing like a ferocious beast when the tamer entered the cage." Written with brilliant clarity and impressionistic economy, Ned Kelly follows Kelly and his outlaw gang of "bushrangers" through the wild land of Australia as they declare war on the police, the bankers, the squatters, the teachers, the preachers, the railway, and the electric telegraph, carrying readers into a dream world of astonishing and violent revelation.

## **F DUNN**

**Dunn, Carola. A colourful death. 1<sup>st</sup> ed. New York : Minotaur Books, 2010.**

Charity shop owner Eleanor Trewynn sets out to find the killer of artist Geoffrey Monmouth, whom both she and her artist friend Nick Gresham, who is being held by the authorities, suspect was responsible for destroying Nick's paintings.

## **F DUNNETT**

**Dunnett, Kaitlyn. Kilt dead. New York : Kensington Books, c2007.**

Professional Scottish dancer Liss MacCrimmon returns to her hometown to help her aunt run a Scottish emporium and soon finds herself pulled into a murder investigation when one of the shop's customers is found dead.

## **F EGAN**

**Egan, Jennifer. A visit from the Goon Squad. 1<sup>st</sup> ed. New York : Alfred A. Knopf, 2010.**

Bennie Salazar, who put aside his days as a punk rocker to be a record executive, reminisces about his younger years and how his adulthood came to be while he remains naive to the inner workings of Sasha, the mid-thirties woman who works with Bennie and harbors a penchant for stealing.

## **F ESTLEMAN**

**Estleman, Loren D. Alone : a Valentino mystery. 1<sup>st</sup> ed. New York : Forge, 2009.**

Valentino is not sure if he should believe Rankin, a developer who claims he is being blackmailed over a letter proving his late wife was having an affair with actress Greta Garbo, but when Rankin kills a man, Valentino decides to take on the case and uncover the truth, no matter whose reputation it could ruin.

## **F EVANOVICH**

**Evanovich, Janet. Sizzling sixteen. 1<sup>st</sup> ed. New York : St. Martin's Press, 2010.**

As Stephanie and her gang prepare for summer vacation their plans are disrupted when it becomes clear that someone wants to kill Vinnie. Meanwhile, Mooner and his bong have returned, Lula's involved in a Ponzi scheme, and Stephanie is chasing a dangerous skip who thinks he'll never be missed.

## **F FAULKS**

**Faulks, Sebastian. A week in December. 1<sup>st</sup> United States ed. New York : Doubleday, c2009.**

Follows the lives of seven London residents in the week before Christmas in 2007, including a hedge fund manager in his attempt to further his career, a professional football player from Poland, a pothead schoolboy with an addiction to reality television, a Tube train driver, and others.

## **F FIRST**

**First thrills : high-octane stories from the hottest thriller authors. New York : Forge, 2010.**

An anthology of previously unpublished work includes contributions by favorite genre authors and a selection of up-and-coming writers.

## **F FORESTER**

**Forester, C. S. (Cecil Scott), 1899-1966. Beat to quarters. Boston : Back Bay Books, 1999.**

Captain Hornblower has been ordered to find a water route across the Central American isthmus and destroy a fifty-gun Spanish ship, but Hornblower finds himself distracted by his newest passenger, the beautiful Lady Barbara Wellesley.

## **F FOWLER**

**Fowler, Earlene. Steps to the altar. 1<sup>st</sup> ed. New York : Berkley Prime Crime, 2002.**

Benni Harper, struggling to protect her marriage from the onslaught of her husband's ex-girlfriend, becomes involved in a decades-old murder mystery when she is asked by the historical society to catalog the contents of some old trunks that belonged to young Maple Bennett Sullivan, a woman believed by many to have killed her husband before running off with a lover.

## **F GERRITSEN**

**Gerritsen, Tess. Ice cold : a Rizzoli & Isles novel. 1<sup>st</sup> ed. New York : Ballantine Books, c2010.**

Boston medical examiner Maura Isles's SUV stalls on a mountain road, leaving her and her friends to seek refuge in the seemingly abandoned village called Kingdom Come, but when Boston homicide detective Jane Rizzoli receives word that Maura's charred body was discovered in a ravine, she sets out to hunt down the killer and unravel the secrets concerning Maura's fate.

## **F GIFFIN**

**Giffin, Emily. Heart of the matter. 1<sup>st</sup> ed. New York : St. Martin's Press, 2010.**

Nick Russo, pediatric plastic surgeon and husband of Tessa, a stay-at-home mom, is called in to treat a six-year-old burn victim; but as he becomes involved in the case, he also finds himself attracted to the child's mother, Valerie.

## **F GIORDANO**

**Giordano, Paolo, 1982-. The solitude of prime numbers. 1<sup>st</sup> American ed. New York : Pamela Dorman Books/Viking, 2010.**

Alice and Mattia thought they were kindred spirits, soul mates meant only for each other, but when Mattia is offered an opportunity that takes him far away, Alice is left bereft and alone, until a chance encounter years later reunites them and Alice must decide if she is willing to trust Mattia with her heart once more.

## **F GOUDGE**

**Goudge, Eileen. The diary. New York : Vanguard Press, c2009.**

The adult daughters of Elizabeth Marshall set out to learn the truth when they discover a diary written by their mother, who is near death following a stroke, in which she tells of the painful choice she made as a young woman between two men.

## **F GRAHAM**

**Graham, Heather. The killing edge. Don Mills, Ont. : Mira, c2010.**

Chloe Marin receives a ghostly visit from a young swimsuit model who has disappeared and uses her experience as a psychologist and police consultant to help find the girl's killer and bring him to justice before he is able to strike again.

## **F GRAHAM LP**

**Graham, Heather. The killing edge. Large print ed. Don Mills, Ont. : MIRA Books, 2010.**

Florida psychologist Chloe Marin and Luke Cane, a British ex-cop-turned-P.I. investigating the disappearance of a young swimsuit model on behalf of her father, have trouble trusting each other, even though they are attracted to one another and have the same hunch that a killer is using a modeling agency to stalk his prey. When Chloe arrives late for an appointment at the modeling agency, she discovers a gruesome mass murder eerily similar to one she witnessed a decade ago—and she's afraid she's the target.

## **F GRAVES**

**Graves, Sarah. Wicked fix. Bantam mass market ed. New York : Bantam Books, 2000.**

Jacobia Tiptree must investigate the murder of despised Eastport native son Reuben Tate when the police trace a bloodied scalpel to surgeon Victor Tiptree, Jacobia's former husband.

## **F GRIPPANDO**

**Grippando, James, 1958-. Money to burn : a novel of suspense. 1<sup>st</sup> ed. New York : Harper, c2010.**

Wall Street investor Michael Cantella arrives at work one morning to discover his accounts have been wiped out, and as he tries to uncover the con artist who is framing him, Michael finds a shocking link to Ivy Layton, the love of his life who vanished on their honeymoon four years earlier.

## **F GRUBER**

**Gruber, Michael, 1940-. The good son : a novel. 1<sup>st</sup> ed. New York : Holt, 2010.**

When special operations soldier Theo Bailey's mother, a Muslim writer and psychologist, attends a peace conference in Pakistan, she and other pacifists are abducted and threatened with death by terrorists who may have access to nuclear weapons; as Theo plans a rescue operation, his mother uses her broad range of talents, including linguistic skills and knowledge of Jungian psychology, to assuage the fears of her fellow captors.

## **F GRUNWALD**

**Grunwald, Lisa. The irresistible Henry House : a novel. 1<sup>st</sup> ed. New York : Random House, c2010.**

Young Henry is forced to confront his the odd circumstances in which he was raised when he participates in a home economics program that uses real babies to teach mothering skills to young women and is reminded of his earliest days as a "practice baby."

## **F HAINES**

**Haines, Kathryn Miller. *When winter returns*. 1<sup>st</sup> ed. New York : Harper Paperbacks, c2010.**

Back from their USO stint in the South Pacific in the fall of 1943, Rosie Winter and her best friend, Jayne, head upstate to visit the home of Jayne's recently deceased fiancé. But what they find leaves Rosie wondering if the man ever existed to begin with. As Rosie searches for the truth behind his identity—and a way to help heal Jayne's broken heart—she faces an unpleasant homecoming of her own. The newspapers are filled with tales of saboteurs infiltrating the East Coast. Her ex, Jack Castlegate, is also back in Manhattan, nursing severe war injuries, under scrutiny for desertion, and engaged to a gorgeous WAC private. Rosie and Jayne's friend Al is in hiding and no one seems willing to help him out. Desperate to make things right, Rosie finds herself telling lie after lie to protect her friends and herself. But as her deceit mounts and lures danger out of hiding, she starts to wonder if they weren't all safer on the warfront than they are on the home front.

## **F HAMILTON**

**Hamilton, Laurell K. *Bullet*. 1<sup>st</sup> ed. New York : Berkley Books, 2010.**

Master vampire Jean-Claude consolidates his power in the United States with help from necromancer Anita Blake and werewolf Richard Zeeman, and when assassins arrive in St. Louis to kill them all, Anita wonders if foreknowledge of the attack is enough to help them survive.

## **F HARRIS**

**Harris, Robert, 1957-. *Conspirata : a novel of ancient Rome*. 1<sup>st</sup> Simon & Schuster hardcover ed. New York : Simon & Schuster, 2010.**

Marcus Cicero assumes control of the Roman Republic only to face treachery, violence, and acts of treason while he struggles to maintain the sanctity of the republic, to ward off assassination attempts, and to prevent a Roman Senator, Gaius Julius Caesar, from taking over and turning Rome into a dictatorship.

## **F HARRIS**

**Harris, Charlaïne. *Dead in the family*. 1<sup>st</sup> ed. New York : Ace Books, 2010.**

Telepathic waitress Sookie Stackhouse, having survived the Fae War but upset over the loss of loved ones and still recovering from the torture she endured, realizes the doors to Faery were closed before some fae were able to leave the human world and they are holding her responsible, while her relationship with vampire Eric Northman is scrutinized by the vampire king and she is drawn into a dangerous debate through her connection to one particular were.

## **F HART**

**Hart, Carolyn G. *Death walked in*. 1<sup>st</sup> ed. New York : William Morrow, c2008.**

Annie and Max Darling are pulled into a murder investigation when the previous owner of the house they are restoring is found dead and they learn the killer believes that hidden inside the Darling's home is a fortune in gold coins.

## **F HASSINGER LP**

**Hassinger, Amy, 1972-. *The priest's madonna*. Large print. Waterville, Me. : Thorndike Press, 2006.**

Marie Dernanaud, raised a religious skeptic, is immediately attracted to Bérenger Saunière, the devout, charismatic priest who takes over the parish of her small town, Rennes-le-Château, in the 1890s. While hiding their dangerous affection for each other behind arguments over religion and revolution, Marie, who narrates, and Bérenger oversee their church's renovation, which turns up some curious artifacts: a map, a book and an ancient stone carving that might hold a Da Vinci-esque code.

## **F HELPRIN**

**Helprin, Mark. *Memoir from Antproof Case : a novel*. New York : Harcourt Brace & Co., c1995.**

An unnamed octogenarian American in Brazil recounts his life. It has taken him down many paths, including that of war hero, banker, lover, murderer, and thief. Throughout, he battles the world's greatest enemy: coffee.

## **F HIJUELOS**
